

Polishing Recommendations

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This is a Type IV alloy which is hard.

Begin with a **Dedeco White Flexie Classic Knife-Edge Abrasive Wheel** (<https://www.dedeco.com/product/728/B-Stylefont-familyelephantfont-weightnormalfont-Color0000font-Size25ClassicfontbbrWHITE-FLEXIESbr-KNIFE-EDGEbr-RUBBER-WHEELSbr-78-222MMbr-100BX/4980/>).

Short, worn bristle brushes are not great, in my opinion. Follow that up with a **soft felt wheel** (https://www.amazon.com/gp/product/B07G75SH4S/ref=ppx_yo_dt_b_asin_title_o03_s00?ie=UTF8&pvc=1), light on pressure and light on polish.

This combination works very well at leaving a smooth, high shine.
